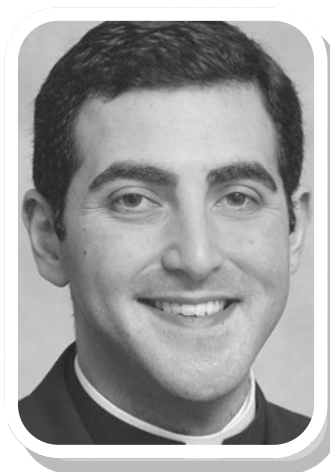
Our Lady and the Beatitudes

This Year's Speaker:

Rev. Fadi Auro

Associate Pastor, Ascension Parish

Born in the United Arab Emirates, Fr. Auro is the child of Iraqi Chaldean Christians who moved to the United States at the start of the first Persian Gulf War in 1991. While studying at the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross in Rome, Fr. Auro first met Raymond Cardinal Burke, then the Archbishop of St. Louis, who invited him to become a seminarian in the archdiocese. Fluent in several languages, Fr. Auro is a "bi-ritual priest," able to offer the Mass in both Eastern and the Latin Rites.

Novena Prayer

Dear Child of Mary,

As the Feast day of Our Lady of Mount Carmel approaches, the Sisters and I invite you to join us for the Solemn Novena in her honor. When you come to the Novena each evening, you come to the land that Mary owns, for she is Mother and Patroness of Carmel, par excellence, and it is she who welcomes you.

For those who wish to participate in the full program, each evening's services begin with a Marian Musical Prelude in the Chapel at 6:45 p.m., followed by Rosary and Benediction at 7:15 p.m. and is climaxed by the Eucharistic Liturgy in the Garden of Carmel at 8:00 p.m.

Each evening during the Homily at Mass, Father Auro will help us to look through the lens of Mary's life to see how she lived the Beatitudes as the first disciple of Christ her Son. When Jesus appeared on this earth, He brought to us the offer of His Love. In following her Son, with Him, she too desires only one thing for us, for our world today and that is Love. We hear of brother hating brother, wars and bloodshed. We hear of Christians and Jews being persecuted and even dying for their Faith.
